- Apply procedures to monitor the quality of own work and take action to ensure that quality standards are met.
- Prevent improvements in own work from slipping back to former or other less efficient practices.
- Identify and implement 5S practices to make improvements in own job and work area.
- Map the requirements for changeover and identify how to reduce waste in the changeover process.
- Prepare for and apply quick changeover according to procedures.
- Use structured process improvement tools to solve process and other problems. It describes the broad application of in-depth and rigorous structured problem-solving techniques to identify opportunities for improvement.
- Analyse manual handling activities and optimise the application of physical effort.
- Effectively analyse the workplace in relation to environmentally sustainable work practices, and to implement improvements and monitor their effectiveness.
