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CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support

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This qualification reflects the role of individuals in the community, home or residential care setting who work under supervision and delegation as a part of a multi-disciplinary team, following an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason.



KEY OUTCOMES

- Organise, provide and monitor personal support services for a person within the limits established by an individualised plan.
- Facilitate the empowerment of people receiving support, and to deliver rights-based services using a person-centred approach.
- Provide individualised services in ways that support independence, as well as, physical and emotional wellbeing.
- Work with basic information about healthy body systems and the impacts of aging and disability.
- Communicate effectively with clients, colleagues, management and other industry providers.
- Work respectfully with people from diverse social and cultural groups and situations, including Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people.
- Work within the legal and ethical frameworks that apply to an individual job role.
- Apply basic infection prevention and control principles in work settings including implementing standard and transmission-based precautions and responding to risks.
- Participate in safe work practices, in work environments that involve caring directly for clients.
- Provide person-centred care and support to people living with dementia.
- Provide care for people with life-limiting illness and those within the normal ageing process using a palliative approach, as well as end-of-life care.
- Work effectively in an aged care work context.
- Work positively with the carer and family of people using a service based on an understanding of their support needs.
- Work in partnership with a person and their family, carer or others identified by the person to recognise and report the risk of falls.

Volume of Learning

Entry Requirements

There are no pre-requisite entry requirements for this course of study. Students must undergo a Language, Literacy & Numeracy evaluation prior to commencement of studies.

Vocational Placement

All students are required to complete Vocational Placement as part of this course to help you develop your skills and knowledge in caring for elderly individuals.

To successfully complete your qualification, you will need to initiate contact with an approved Registered Aged Care Facility to complete workplace-based experience and solidify practical experience and skills relevant to the qualification.

Students are all required to demonstrate evidence that they have completed a minimum of 120 hours of direct support work in at least one aged care, home and community, disability or community service organisation for the CHCCS040 Support independence and wellbeing unit.

Assessment

The assessment in this qualification involves a variety of workbook activities, practical tasks, and project work. Participants will be supported by their trainer throughout their journey.
